BASIL EDMUND KING TROPHY for best vase of Roses classes 1-6

1. **Roses** - Large Flowered - any cultivar(s) 3 blooms, 1 vase.
2. **Roses** - Any one cultivar, any size, 3 blooms, 1 vase.
3. **Roses** - Large Flowered - any cultivar 1 bloom, 1 vase.
4. **Roses** - Cluster Flowered - 3 stems, 1 vase.
5. **Roses** - any cultivars - 3 stems, 1 vase. See rule 21 - NOVICE CLASS.
6. **Roses** - 1 large bloom, climbing rose.
7. **Roses** - Display of mixed roses in a bowl. Max size 180mm wide.

8. **Sweet Peas - single colour** - 5 stems, 1 vase.

FLOWERS

19. **House/Pot Plant** - in bloom or fruiting. Maximum pot diameter 300mm. See rule 21.
20. **House/Pot Plant** - ornamental foliage. Maximum pot diameter 300mm. See rule 21.
21. **An Orchid in bloom** - maximum pot diameter 400mm. See rule 21.
22. **Pelargonium** - maximum pot diameter 300mm. See rule 21.
23. **Mixed Flowers** - arranged for effect, any foliage, 1 jam jar/vase - maximum diameter, 230mm. See rule 21.

24. **Herbaceous perennials** - mixed, arranged for effect, 1 jam jar/vase - maximum diameter, 230mm. See rule 21.
25. **Annuals** - mixed, arranged for effect, 1 jam jar/vase - maximum diameter, 230mm. See rule 21.
